To link the two, the outstanding future leaders, Forum alumni will be offered to participate as speakers at the future Prague European Summits. This will add value to the Prague European Summit, bringing innovative solutions and shedding light on youth perspectives.

The organizers will provide all of the participants with accommodation. The organizes will not cover travel costs to Prague, however a number of travel grants for candidates of various backgrounds and nationalities may be ensured. Travel grants may be awarded to selected participants on an individual basis and only up to the amount decided by the organizers.

- Interest in EU affairs, its political and economic development, security, and/or any other fields of relevance to the European affairs
- Fluent in English
- Willingness to actively engage in debates and within the Prague European Summit discussions
- Willingness to participate in any other related activities
