Managing imperial decline: a new EU policy towards Russia

Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine has shattered the post-Cold War international order built upon East-West interdependence and cooperation. The European Union must now adapt to the geopolitical reality of Russian neo-revisionism. Hugo Blewett-Mundy, an Associate Research Fellow at EUROPEUM Institute, identifies four areas where the EU's policy towards Russia could evolve to confront this emerging security situation in Europe.
