WORKSHOP STRUCTURE:

- **Two Online Workshops:** Engage in interactive sessions with fellow students and experts.
 - Dates: TBC, indicatively 3rd October and 10th October 2024
 - Duration: Half-day sessions.
- **Final Conference:** A half-day conference in Prague on 13th November 2024, where selected students will present their papers with the possibility to attend selected events from the Transatlantic Policy Forum, organized by EUROPEUM Institute on 14th November 2024.

YOUR COMMITMENT:

- **Written Assignment:** After the workshops, each student will submit a 3-4 page paper elaborating on their arguments regarding NATO's enlargement to Eastern Europe.
- **Evaluation and Selection:** Papers will be reviewed by experts from EUROPEUM Institute. At least one selected student from each country will be able to attend the Prague conference and present their papers. Funding for travel and stay in Prague will be available for those selected.
